Note: The date and venue are tentative and subject to change. Final date and venue will be mentioned in the Admit Card issued for the Rally.

1. Note/ Advisory : Grant of One Time Age Relaxation.

(a) Recruitment processes for Soldier Technical Nursing Assistant/Nursing Assistant Veterinary held in recruiting years 2020-21 & 2021-22 were suspended due to COVID-19 Pandemic. The validity period of medical test is for 180 days and the same has lapsed being no more valid in respect of candidates who are awaiting conduct of CEE as also considerable time has elapsed post the conduct of physical test. Hence, there is a requirement of conducting fresh physical and medical tests in respect of said candidates.

(b) In order to provide opportunity to all candidates, two years age relaxation has been granted for recruiting year 2022-23. Candidates who had passed their physical fitness test and recruitment medicals in recruiting years 2020-21 & 2021-22 and are still willing for recruitment are advised to re-apply online on Join Indian Army Website, www.joinindianarmy.nic.in and undergo the process of physical and medical test again.

2. Procedure for Online Registration.

(a) All candidates to log in to www.joinindianarmy.nic.in, check their eligibility status and create their profile.

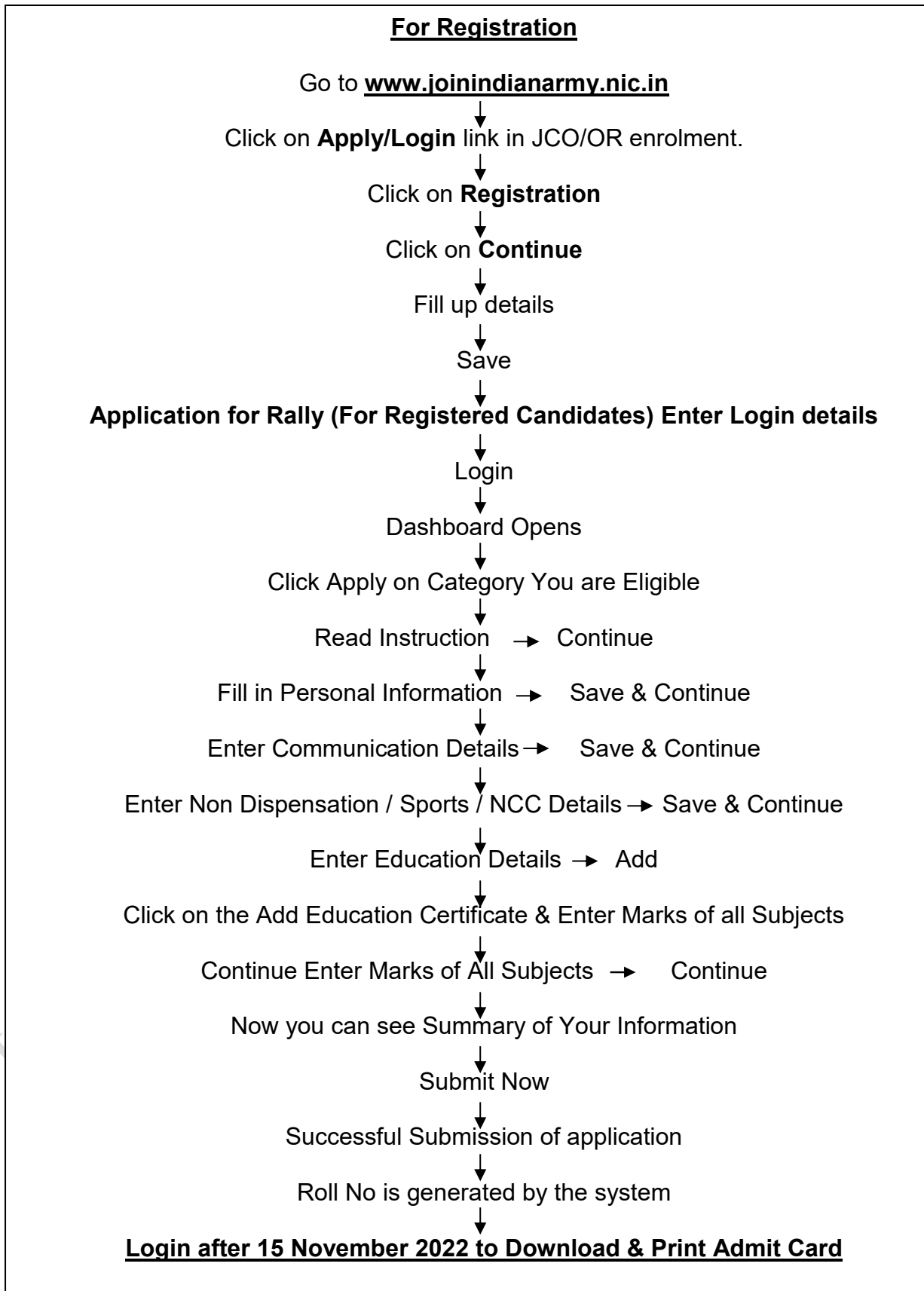
(b) Online Registration (submission of application) will commence from **01 October 2022** and close on **30 October 2022**.

(c) Kindly read instructions for registration and fill application forms carefully as given in the www.joinindianarmy.nic.in website.

(d) Candidates will login after **15 November 2022** and take printout of the admit card which they will carry to Rally Site.

(e) Candidates will be allowed to participate in the Rally only if they produce the Admit Card. Affidavit for details duly attested by notary and as per format is as given at **Appendix 'A'**.

4. **Editing/ Correction of Online Application.** Online application on www.joinindianarmy.nic.in has edit option available till the registration is open (01 October 2022 to 30 October 2022). Please use it and correct the details if required/ necessary. Candidate must ensure to submit the application again after the edit/ correction has been carried out.

5. Army Recruitment Rally for Soldier Technical Nursing Assistant/Nursing Assistant Veterinary will be held at Morahbadi Ground, Ranchi in Jan 2023. **Admit Card for the rally will be sent through registered email after 15 November 2022.** Candidates shall reach the venue on given date and time as mentioned in the Admit Card.

6. The screening of candidates will be carried out for **Soldier Technical Nursing Assistant/Nursing Assistant Veterinary as per following qualitative requirement:-**

#(a) The upper age limit has been relaxed from 23 years to 25 years as a onetime measure for the Recruiting Year 2022-23.

(b) Special Instructions For Adivasi Candidates. Following physical standards applicable for **Adivasi Candidates only:-**

Minimum Height - 162 cms, Minimum Weight (Kgs) - As uploaded on JIA website and Minimum Chest - 77 cm (+5 cm expansion). **Adivasi Candidates should bring caste certificate duly signed by District Magistrate only.**

Physical measurements will be carried out as per the Physical Standards listed at Para 6 above.				
Medical Test				
(a) As per laid down medical standards at the Rally Site.				
(b) Medical standards and procedure of medical examination is as uploaded on the JIA website.				
(c) Unfit candidates will be referred to MH / CH / BH for specialist review (The opinion of the specialist is final and no further review is permissible). Candidates to report to designated Military Hospital within Five days from referral and review medical exam to be completed by Military Hospital within 14 days as per policy. Candidates referred for specialist review should report back to Army Recruiting Office Ranchi for issue of admit card for CEE in case declared FIT.				
(d) If 180 days or more lapse between the medical at the Rally and dispatch, medical will be done again and unfit candidates in this review will not be recruited.				

Written Test Through Common Entrance Examination (CEE)

- (a) Will be conducted for medically fit candidates at nominated venue. Location, date and time of written test will be intimated at rally site and through Admit Cards.
- (b) Admit Card for the CEE for the rally fit candidates will be issued at Rally Site itself.
- (c) Admit Card for the CEE for the review fit cases will be issued by Army Recruiting Office, Ranchi on the date to be intimated once candidates report to the Army Recruiting Office after being declared medically fit by concerned specialist/specialists at MH / CH / BH.

10. **Documents to be Brought to Rally Site.** Candidates are required to bring following documents/ certificates in **original along with two attested photocopies** with them to the rally site :-

- (a) **Admit Card.** Printed on Laser Printer on good quality paper (**Do not shrink the size**).
- (b) **Photographs.** Twenty (20) copies of unattested Passport size colour photographs developed on good quality photographic paper in white background not more than three months old. **Computerised/ photocopied/ photo shopped photographs will NOT be accepted. Photographs must be with proper haircut and clean shave (Except Sikh candidates).**
- (c) **Education Certificates.**
- (i) **Education Certificates with Marks Sheets and Board Certificates in original** of all educational qualifications achieved by candidate i.e. **Matric/ Intermediate** etc from recognised School/ College/ Board/ University.
- (ii) **Provisional/ online education certificate** should be certified and ink signed by the head of the educational institution of concerned Board/University. **School Leaving Certificate (SLC) and College Leaving Certificate (CLC)** will be carried by all the candidates.
- (iii) Candidates with **matric certificate from Open School** should bring School Leaving Certificate countersigned by BEO/DEO.
- (iv) List of **Education Boards** recognized by State Governments/UT administrations attached as **Appendix 'B'** will only be accepted.
- (d) **Domicile (Nativity) Certificate.** Domicile (Nativity) Certificate generated online through Bihar/Jharkhand Government website, digitally signed by Circle Officer and countersigned by SDO/Tehsildar/ District Magistrate which can be verified from Government web site will only be acceptable.
- (e) **Class/ Caste Certificate.** Class/Caste Certificate generated online through Bihar/Jharkhand Government website as applicable, digitally signed by Circle Officer and countersigned by SDO/Tehsildar/District Magistrate which can be verified from Government web site will only be accepted. For **Adivasi candidates' caste certificate issued in a similar manner but countersigned and stamped by District Magistrate only will be acceptable.**
- (f) **Religion Certificate.** Religion Certificate to be issued by the Tehsildar/ SDM. (To be brought if religion as **"SIKH/HINDU/MUSLIM/CHRISTIAN"** is not mentioned in the caste certificate).

(g) **School Character Certificate.** School Character Certificate issued by the School/ College Principal/ Headmaster where the candidate has last studied.

(h) **Character Certificate.** Character Certificate with photograph affixed on the certificate issued by Village Sarpanch/ Municipal Corporation **within last six months** from the date of despatch (**Certificate issued by Mukhia will not be acceptable**).

(j) **Character Certificate Issued by SP/SSP Office.** Character Certificate duly affixed with individual's photograph issued **digitally by SP/SSP Office of district concerned within last six months** which can be verified from Government web site. This is applicable for candidates of Bihar State, whereas **candidates of Jharkhand State** are required to bring the Character Certificate issued by **SP/SSP office of district concerned within last six months**.

(k) **Unmarried Certificate.** Unmarried Certificate for candidates less than 21 years of age affixed with photograph (signed and stamped), issued by Village Sarpanch/ Municipal Corporation **within last six months**. (**Format of Unmarried Certificate attached as Appendix 'C'**).

Note (Important Instructions For Documents/Certificates):-

- (i) No Tatkal Nativity Certificate will be acceptable.
- (ii) **Character certificate** and **Unmarried certify cate** issued by **Mukhia** will not be accepted.
- (iii) **Character certificate** without photo attested by certificate issuing authority will be rejected.
- (iv) **Caste Certificate** of **Adivasi** candidate should be signed by **District Magistrate**.
- (v) Carrying of original AADHAR Card is mandatory for participation in the rally.
- (vi) **Multiple Nativity.** Candidates participating in different rallies using multiple nativity certificates will be rejected under fraudulent enrolment and will be liable for legal action in addition to rejection of candidature.

(l) **Relationship Certificate.** SOS/SOEX/SOW/SOWW candidates are required to produce the following documents:-

- (i) **Relationship certificate** issued from respective Records Office only, duly signed by Records Officer with Personal Number, Rank, Name and particulars of the Records Officer issuing the Relationship Certificate with office seal/stamp is endorsed. **Relationship certificate to bear water mark of the concerned Records.**
- (ii) A **declaration** to the effect as mentioned in Affidavit on Ten Rupees Non-Judicial Stamp paper prepared by the ESM duly signed by 1st Class/ Executive/ Judicial Magistrate is required to be submitted by the candidate at rally site. **Format of affidavit attached as Appendix 'D'**.
- (iii) **Original Discharge Book** of ESM also to be produced. Name and date of birth of the candidate must have been recorded in it.

(m) **NCC Certificate.** **NCC A/B/C certificate** and **Republic Day Parade** certificate should have photograph of the candidate duly attested by issuing authority. **Provisional NCC A/B/C pass certificate will only be accepted if authenticated by concerned NCC Group Commanders. An undertaking to the effect will be obtained from the candidate.** Provisional certificates are accepted only during the notified rally duration, neither earlier nor later.

Note: **NCC certificate produced at the rally site only will be valid for bonus marks. No NCC certificate will be accepted after rally.**

(n) **Sports Certificate.**

(i) Sportsmen who have represented India at International level or State at National level within the last two years.

(ii) For list of sports under which relaxation in physical standards is admissible, attention is invited to www.joinindianarmy.nic.in website and **Appendix 'E'** of this notification.

(iii) Sportsmen who have represented District at State level and University team or Regional team at District level within last two years. Sports certificates should be with registration number and from government recognized sports institutes/bodies as under :-

Note:- **No bonus marks will be allotted unless the certificates (Relationship/ Sports/ NCC) have been verified.**

(o) **Affidavit**. Signed by candidate on Rs 10/- Non-Judicial Stamp Paper as per specimen duly attested by notary will be submitted by candidate at the Rally Site without fail. **Format of affidavit attached as Appendix 'A'. Submission of affidavit is mandatory to gain entry into the Rally Site. Candidates WILL NOT BE PERMITTED to enter the Rally Site without the affidavit. Incomplete affidavit will not be accepted. All details as applicable including records of participation of previous rallies must be duly filled up typed.**

(p) **Certificates For Bonus Marks**. All original certificates/ photocopies duly attested pertaining to bonus marks will be accepted only during the Rally. **No certificate to include NCC Certificate, Sports Certificate, Relationship Certificate or any other certificate to claim Bonus Marks/ Relaxation would be accepted after termination of the Rally.**

(q) **Single Bank Account, PAN Card & AADHAR Card**. Single Bank account, PAN Card & AADHAR Card are **mandatory documents** for final enrolment for the purpose of Pay & Allowances and other social benefits scheme.

(r) Sarpanch/ Nagar Sewak (Residence Proof) within last six months.

(s) **Additional Documents in Original Required From Students of Education Boards Other Than Those Listed at Serial Number 4 of Appendix 'B'**. The students of Education Boards other than those listed at **serial number 4 of Appendix 'B'** are strongly advised to bring maximum number of documents out of the following or any such similar documents to prove beyond doubt their credentials of being a domicile (native) of Bihar and Jharkhand: -

- (i) Latest House Electricity Bill.
- (ii) Family Ration Card.
- (iii) Bank Pass Book for Place of Residence.
- (iv) Family Gas Connection Pass Book.
- (v) Agriculture Land Ownership Document.

(t) **Additional Certificates**. Candidates are also required to bring following certificates as applicable:-

- (i) **Indemnity Bond/ Certificate**. For details, refer para 19 of the notification.
- (ii) **Non Use of Performance Enhancing Drugs Certificate**. For details, refer para 21 of the notification.
- (iii) **Tattoo Certificate (If Applicable)**. For details, refer para 23 of the notification.
- (iv) COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate.

Note: Candidates are strongly advised to carry as many documents as possible in the Digilocker format also to facilitate ease of their verification.

(i) Maximum bonus marks that can be given is 20 Marks even if a candidate qualifies for more than one type of bonus marks.		
(ii) The above marks are fixed depending upon the eligibility of a candidate and has no relation to his performance in Common Entrance Examination (CEE).		
(iii) Only one type of Bonus Marks (Max of the permissible) will be added to the total.		
(iv) Bonus marks will be accorded on qualifying in the written examination.		
(v) Only one ward (son) of Service/ Ex-Servicemen/ War Widow/ Widow of Ex-servicemen can avail bonus marks in written examination.		
(vi) Original certificates to be carried by all above categories at rally site.		
(vii) Sports certificate are valid for two years from the issue date as on first day of the recruitment rally for which the candidate is being screened.		

12. **Special Instructions.**

- (a) **Any candidate who does not receive the admit card five days prior to the Rally, may approach Army Recruiting Office, Ranchi for further clarification.**
- (b) **For online registration & online application, assistance will also be provided to candidates at Army Recruiting Office, Ranchi on all working days from 1000 hours to 1300 hours.**
- (c) **01 October 2022 will be taken as effective date of determining age eligibility for the candidate. Candidates to produce 10th class/ birth certificate at the time of preliminary document check.**
- (d) Candidates are required to report at the Rally Site by 0100 hours on their respective scheduled dates. Candidates reporting after 0600 hours without appropriate justification will not be permitted to participate in the Rally. **Candidate should be clean shaven** (Except Sikh candidates).
- (e) Personnel e-mail ID and Mobile Number of the candidate are a **MUST**. All important messages will be sent to the candidates e-mail ID/ Mobile Number like short listed/ call letter/ joining instructions/ result etc. Sharing of e-mail ID and Mobile Number with another candidate is not permitted. Remember the User Name and Password for future use. **(ARO will not be responsible for any information not received by the candidate if e-mail/ Mobile Number given by candidate is wrong/ has been changed).**
- (f) Candidate must carry their AADHAR card which will be authenticated biometrically at the Rally Site. Candidates to ensure AADHAR card details are matching with the details mentioned in the documents and the Online Application. Candidates from J&K, Assam and Meghalaya are to carry any other valid ID Proof.
- (g) Candidate's name, father's name, mother's name and date of birth must be entered exactly as per Matriculation/ 10th Class Board Certificate.
- (h) Candidate must enter contact details and permanent home address exactly as per Domicile/ Nativity/ Permanent Residential Certificate issued by Sub Divisional Magistrate/ District Magistrate.
- (j) Those not in possession of required documents will not be permitted to participate in the Rally.
- (k) **Touts. In the past, a number of candidates have been found victims of touts, fake documents/ impersonation and in the bargain have lost their candidature. Modus operandi/ means used by the touts are as under :-**
- (i) **Issue of fake Physical Fitness Test slip/ Impersonation as recruitment officer during various stages of rally. Conduct fake recruitment rallies.**
- (ii) **Snatching/ taking away original certificate from candidates who have been declared fit at initial stage and thereafter harassing them.**
- (iii) **Taking away "ADMIT CARD" from the candidates under plea that they will follow up their results.**

- (iv) **Giving candidates false assurance of “RECRUITMENT” as they claim to have links at appropriate level, thereby winning confidence of candidates.**
- (v) **Once a candidate gets through on his own efforts, touts demand money in return of the original certificates.**
- (l) A Grievance Cell will be established at the rally site to redress any grievances.
- (m) Candidates are requested to report at rally site with proper shave and haircut so as to ensure proper identification & Medical Review.
- (n) **Recruitment is purely based on merit list depending on available vacancies. Candidates do not have any right to claim recruitment in Army just for passing in the recruitment process.**
- (o) Candidates not in possession of requisite certificates are liable for rejection.

Important Instructions

13. **Candidates will be permitted entry into the rally site only on production of Admit Card in duplicate generated online through the official website www.joinindianarmy.nic.in. Anyone found with fake admit card will be handed over to the Civil Police.**
14. Recruitment into the Army is a **free service**. Candidates are advised **not to pay bribe to anyone for recruitment as it is based purely on merit**. Selection process during recruitment at all stages is computerised and transparent. Therefore, candidates are advised to be **beware of touts as they cannot help them at any stage**.
15. Giving/ taking bribe, production of bogus/ fake certificates and indulging in unfair means is a criminal offence and liable for punishment under law.
16. Candidate are advised to check their age & education criteria before participating in the rally. Candidates found under age/ overage and not meeting education criteria will be disqualified.
17. Certificates with overwriting, tampering of seals or erasing/ alteration of any type will not be accepted.
18. All documents submitted by the candidates are verified by government agencies before enrolment into the Army. Strong legal action will be taken against individuals submitting fake documents. Even after recruitment, the service will be terminated if candidates are found to have produced fake documents or have given wrong information at the time of recruitment, despite the number of years of service individual may have rendered.
19. No compensation for Death/ injury/ loss etc during the rally and no travelling allowance/ dearness allowance for journey is admissible. **Candidates will participate in the rally at their own risk and the participation is totally and entirely voluntary**. The signing of **Indemnity Bond is a mandatory requirement**. The format of the **Indemnity Bond is attached as Appendix ‘F’**.
20. **Candidate to come for the rally only on the date as per Admit Card**. Candidates should bring pen and handkerchief.

21. **Use of Performance Enhancing Drugs.** Use of any kind of performance enhancing drugs is strictly banned. Any candidate found in possession of or to have used the same will be debarred from further screening. A certificate attached as **Appendix 'G' will be submitted.**
22. **Amendment in Any Documents.** Any amendment made in any document produced at rally site (For example change in name/ DOB/ address in education certificate, AADHAR Card, PAN Card etc) should be prior to the issue of notification. Any change after publication of notification will not be accepted and their candidature will be rejected.
23. **Tattoo.**
- (a) Candidates belonging to tribal communities/ from tribal areas are permitted to have permanent body tattoos on any part of the body, as per existing customs and traditions of the said tribe to which a candidate belongs. Such candidates will only be permitted on producing the following two certificates :-
- (i) Self certificate to be signed by candidate, format attached as **Appendix 'H-I'**.
- (ii) Certificate of belonging to a tribal community and permissibility of permanent body tattoo(s) as per format at **Appendix 'H-II'** to be signed by one of the following officials :-
- (aa) DC/DM or SDM of the District/Tehsil where the tribe of the candidate is presently settled (Name and designation of the concerned official must be clearly mentioned).
- (ab) Chairman/ Secretary or any other senior member of the Tribe (Name, designation if any and address of the concerned member will be clearly mentioned).
- (b) Permanent body tattoos of religious sentiment are only permitted on inner face of forearms i.e. from inside of elbow to the wrist and on the reverse side of palm/ back (dorsal) side of hand. Permanent body tattoos on any other part of the body are not acceptable and candidates will be barred from further selection.
24. Selection is provisional till Enrolment Form/Rahdari Certificate is issued and candidates are dispatched for training.
25. Mobile phones are not permitted in the rally site and at the time of CEE.
26. CEE for the selected candidates will be held tentatively in the month of Feb 2023, date and venue of exam for which will be intimated during issue of admit cards for CEE.
27. Negative marking would be applicable in CEE.
28. At the rally site, all candidates should report duly shaved (beard, chest, hair, axillary hair, pubic hair and with crew cut (Except Sikh candidates), for identification at various stages of rally process failing which candidates can be barred from participation in the recruitment rally.
29. Candidates may have to present themselves at the rally site two to three times. Candidates should therefore make arrangements for stay under their own arrangements.

30. Candidates are advised in their own interest to undergo medical exam before coming for selection especially with respect to flat foot, poor vision, deformities and physical measurements. All are advised to ensure that their ears are free of wax by getting it cleaned by a doctor prior to the rally.

31. If 180 days or more lapse between screening medical at the rally and despatch, medicals will be done again and unfit candidates in this review will not be recruited.

32. **Vaccination Certificate.** All candidates appearing for rally should be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 (**First and second dose**). The certificate to be produced to the authority upon asking.

33. No use of contact lenses.

34. **Result of written examination will be declared on the official website www.joinindianarmy.nic.in.** No separate letter will be sent to the candidate. It is responsibility of candidate to check his result and report to the concerned ARO for documentation.

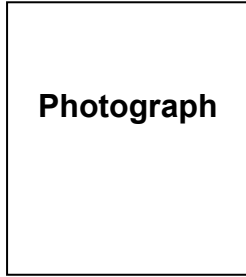
