TERRITORIAL ARMY RECRUITMENT OF 115 INFANTRY BATTALION (TA) MAHAR AT FORT BELGAUM

SELECTION IN THE TERRITORIAL ARMY IS 'FAIR & TRANSPARENT' AND ON MERIT ONLY. AT NO STAGE ANY BRIBE IS TO BE PAID TO ANYONE FOR SELECTION OR RECRUITMENT IN THE TERRITORIAL ARMY. CANDIDATES SHOULD NOT FALL PREY TO UNSCRUPULOUS PERSONS POSING AS RECRUITING AGENTS.

- This unit will conduct the recruitment in Territorial Army from **17 May 2023 to 03 June 2023** at 115 Infantry Battalion (Territorial Army) MAHAR, Fort Belgaum, Karnataka. All Eligible Candidate are required to apply online through Territorial Army **recruitment website** rectt-territorialarmy.co.in Online registration is mandatory and will be open from **06 Mar 2023 to 12 Mar 2023**. Admit Cards for the rally will be sent through **registered e-mail** Candidates should be reached at the venue on given date and time as mentioned in the **Admit Card**.
- Total No of vacancies are as under:-
 - Soldier GD** - 158 (One hundred fifty eight)
 - Clerk Staff Duties** - 14 (Fourteen)
 - Washerman** - 09 (Nine)
 - Chief Community** - 13 (thirteen)
 - Steward** - 11 (eleven)
 - Carpenter** - 15 (fifteen)
- The Qualitative Requirement (OR) is as under -
 - For Soldier GD.** 10th Pass (SSLC) with 45% marks in aggregate and candidates having qualification for general duty and passed his PUC(10+2) or above having less than 45% in SSLC (10th class) can also apply.
 - Clerk (Staff Duty).** 10+2/intermediate exam paas from any stream (Arts, Science & Commerce with English) with min 50% aggregate marks and min 40% marks in each subject Indl with proficiency in computer and typing will be given additional weightage of 20% as bonus marks on the marks attained by the candidate in written exam.

(c) **Tradesman.** 10th(Simple Pass) with original school certificate and should have obtained proficiency in the trade.

- (g) Height - 160 Cms.
- (h) Weight - 50 Kgs.
- (i) Chest - 77-82 Cms (with chest expansion 5 cms).
- (j) Age - Between 18 to 42 Years.
- (k) Gainfully employed in Govt/Semi Govt/ Pvt Sector or self employed
- (l) Candidates must be domicile of **KARNATAKA, GUJRAT, KERALA, TAMIL NADU, ANDHRA PRADESH, RAJASTHAN, MAHARASHTRA, GOA, THE UNION TERRITORIES OF DADAR AND NAGAR HAVELI, DAMAN & DIU, LAKSHADWEEP AND PUDUCHERRY.**

4. **Eligibility.** Prior to a volunteer being permitted for appearing for recruitment following will be established :-

- (a) Bears a good character.
- (b) Should have attained the age of 18 years and should not have attained the age of 42 Years
- (c) Should be resident of the state mentioned in para 3(g)
- (d) If he in service of any Central / State government of Public Utility service he has to obtain permission from the Government for enrolment and also a certificate to the effect that his service will forthwith be made available for service in the Territorial Army. whenever required
- (e) He should not belong to any reserve force.
- (f) He should not be having any reserve liability.
- (g) He should not have been dismissed from services from Territorial Army, Regular Army, Navy or Air Force.
- (h) He should not be having more than one wife
- (i) He should not have been convicted of an offence in criminal court

(j) **Any candidate with a permanent tattoo on any non-permissible part of the body in NOT eligible for enrolment Such a candidate will be rejected by the screening team, as soon as the non-permissible tattoo is noticed at any stage of the recruiting procedure. However, candidate sporting permanent tattoo on the following body parts only are eligible for enrolment :-**

- (i) **Inner face of the arms, i.e. from inside of elbow to the wrist**
- (ii) **Back (dorsal) part of the hand/reverse side of palm.**

5. **Physical fitness Tests.** Physical fitness test will be conducted from **17 May 2023 to 03 June 2023** Only selected candidates will be called for Documentation, Medical and written test.

- (a) 1.6 Kms Run - (Time - 5 minutes 40 seconds)

- (b) Beam - Candidates should be able to do 10 times or more
- (c) 9 feet ditch - Should be able to cross by jumping
- (d) Zig Zag Balance - Should be able to do quality.

6. The candidates should be physically fit and will undergo a medical examination prior to enrolment.

7 Terms and Conditions :-

(a) The candidate has to be gainfully employed. Candidates should bring No Objection Certificate from their employer.

(b) The selected candidates will be employed a 115 In B (TA) MAHAR.

(c) **Recruit Training.** Once the candidate is enrolled, he will be trained as recruit for the period of one month from the date of enrolment and 09 months Young Soldier training in The Mahar Reg Centre. Saugor (MP) Thereafter he will be disembodied till fresh vacancies for allotment are released.

(d) **Annual Training Camp.** The candidates will be recalled for embodiment for two months Annual Training Camp each year and will be disembodied on completion of said Annual Training Camp.

(e) **Rule-33 under TA Act 1948 During emergency period :-**

- (i) To render military service alongside Indian Army during war & peace
- (ii) To support Indian Army during Counter Insurgency Operations.
- (iii) To support the civil administration in maintaining essential service

8. The selected candidates will be employed in 115 Inf B (TA) MAHAR as soldier (Combatant). The pay and other facilities will be as under :-

- (a) During (probation) -Rs 5700/- appx per month
- (b) After probation -Rs 5200+2000 (Grade Pay) (M S Pay) + DA
- (c) Free food, accommodation and uniform.
- (d) CSD facilities.
- (e) Free medical facilities.
- (f) Other allowances at par with Regular Army.

9. **Documents.** The following documents are required :-

- (a) Original and Photocopy of SSLC certificates.
- (b) Original and Photocopy of school leaving certificate

- (c) Eight passport size photographs
- (d) Domicile certificate
- (e) Character certificate from civil police
- (f) Married/unmarried certificate duly signed by Registrar/Gram Sarpanch.

10. Miscellaneous Points :-

- (a) Service in Territorial Army is part time On enrollment. a person has to compulsorily attend annual training camp for two months in a year. In addition to this, he can be called for other type of training, if he is willing to attend. When summoned under Rule-33 for duties in national interests, it is obligatory on his part to rejoin duty forthwith
- (b) Only candidates within the age, education and physical measurement profile meeting the criteria as given in Para 4 above may report at rally site. Candidates found not having the above mentioned certificates will be sent back from the rally site.
- (c) Certificate of provisional nature will not be entertained
- (d) Enrolment is purely merit based and according to the vacancies available
- (e) Son of serving Soldiers/ Son of Ex Soldiers / Son of Widows / Son of War Widows will be given benefits only if they produce requisite certificate from Record office / DSRS Board / Station Headquarters.
- (f) Candidates are advised to get themselves medically checked before coming for selection in respect of flat foot. vision and minor ailments and also advised to have the wax from their ears removed before hand
- (g) The authorities conducting the rally will not be responsible for any accident / injuries to the candidates during the recruitment rally.
- (h) Malpractices and attempted enrolment by producing fake certificates during the recruitment rally will call for action against the defaulter by the police. Police pers will be present during the rally.
