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UNIT HEADQUARTERS QUOTA RECRUITMENT RALLY PROGRAMME FOR THE RECRUITING YEAR 2022-23 (AGNIVEER DEMAND NO - 01)

 Special Instructions: The salient aspects of terms and conditions of service for persons enrolled through the Agnipath Scheme for service in the IA are mentioned in the succeeding paragraphs.

2. Terms and conditions

(a) Enrolment.

- (i) Candidate will be enrolled under Army Act 1950 for service duration of four (04) years including the training period.
- (ii) Agniveers so enrolled will be subject to Army Act 1950 and will be liable to go wherever ordered by land, sea or air.
- (iii) Agniveers enrolled under the scheme will not be eligible for any kind of Pension or Gratuity.

(b) Service.

- (i) Service of Agniveers will commence from the date of enrollment.
- (ii) Agniveers would form a distinct rank in the IA different from any other existing ranks.
- (iii) Leave, Uniform, Pay & Allowances during the service period of four years will be governed by orders and instruction in respect of such individuals issued by the Government of India (GOI) from time to time.
- (iv) Agniveers will be liable to be assigned any duty in organizational interest, as decided from time to time.
- (v) Personnel enrolled through Agniveers Scheme, will be required to undergo periodical medical check-ups and physical/written/field tests as governed by orders issued. The performance so demonstrated would be considered for subsequent offer for enrolment in the Regular Cadre.

(c) Discharge

- (i) All Agniveers will be discharged on completion of four years of service.
- (ii) On discharge after completion of four years, Agnivees will be paid a 'Seva Nidhi' package to enable them to return to the society for pursuing employment in the other sectors.
- (iii) Agniveers will not be eligible for any kind of pension or gratuity, neither will they be eligible for Ex Servicemen Contributory Health Scheme (ECHS), Canteen Stores Department (CSD) facilities Ex Servicemen status and other related benefits.
- (iv) Agniveers will be barred from disclosing classified information gained during service to any unauthorized person or source under Official Secrets Act, 1923.

(d) Enrolment for Regular Cadre.

- (i) Based on organizational requirements and policies promulgated Agniveers who are completing their engagement period in each batch will be offered on opportunity to apply for enrolment in the regular cadre of IA. These applications will be considered in a centralized manner by the army based on an objective criteria including performance during their engagement period and not more than 25% of each specific batch of Agniveers will be enrolled in regular cadre of the IA, post completion of their four years engagement period.
- (ii) Agniveers so enrolled as regular cadre would be required to serve for a further engagement period of 15 years and will be governed by terms and conditions of service (of junior Commissioned Officers/ Other Ranks in IA) as currently in vogue (as amended from time to time). Agniveers will not have any right to be selected. Selection will be exclusive to the jurisdiction of the IA.
- (iii) With introduction of this Scheme, the enrolment of Soldiers in the regular cadre of IA, except technical cadres of Medical Branch, will be available only to those personnel who have completed their engagement period as Agniveer.

Employability.

- (a) Agniveers will be liable to be assigned any duty in organisational interest, as decided from time to time.
- (b) Agniveers can be posted to any regiment/ Unit and can be further transferred to other regiments/ Units in the organizational interest.
- Leave Grant of leave will be subject to exigencies of service. The fwg leave may be applicable for Agniveers during their engagement period;-
 - (a) Annual Leave. Upto 30 days per year.
 - (b) Sick Leave. Based on medical advice.

5. Pay, Allowoacea & Allied Denefits

(a) Aggiveers Package

(i) The pay & emoluments of Agriveers will be as given below-

- (ii) From the above package, 30% will be compulsorily deposited every month in a corpus which will be matched by the GOt Balance amount less the corpus contribution will be the in-hand component.
- (b) Seva Nidhi Package On discharge at 4 years, the corpus of ₹ 5.02 lakhs will be matched by the GOI, an amount of ₹ 10.04 lakhs and accrued interest will be given to the Agniveers. In case of Agniveers who are subsequently selected for enrollment in IA as regular cadre, the "Seva Nidhi" package to be paid to them will compromise only their contribution including accrued interest thereon. In the case of Agniveers exiting service before the end of their engagement period on their own request, the individuals Seva Nidhi package, accumulated as on date, will be paid with the applicable rate of interest. In such cases, no Govt contribution to Seva Nidhi Package will be entitled. The "Seva Nidhi" will be exempt from Income Tax.
- (c) Payment Modality Seva Nidhi Package. Two options to receive Seva Nidhi package will be provided to each Agriveer, with an aim to provide financial loans for self employment/, entrepreneurship through a bank Guarantee as also to meet immediate/ incidental expenses, on exit. Firm details will be promulgated separately.
- (d) Allowances. The Agniveer pay is a composite package and he/ she will not be sligible any Dearness Allowances and Military Service Pay. He/ she will get applicable Risk & Hardship, Ration, Dress and travel allowances as decided by the GOF from time to time.
- (e) Agriveers will be exempted from making any contribution in Armed Forces Personnel Provident Fund or any other Provident Fund.
- (f) There shall be no entitlement towards gratuity or pensionary benefits for Agniveers enrolled through this scheme.
- Life Insurance Cover. Agriveer will be provided non-contributory life insurance cover of ₹ 48 takhs for the duration of their engagement period and they will not be eligible for Army Group Insurance Fund (AGIF) Schemes/ benefits.

7. Termination/ Release from Service.

- (a) The maximum period of service for Agniveers will be as enumerated at Para 2 above. However, the service of Agniveers under this scheme may be terminated at any time in accordance with the Army Act 1950.
- (b) Release at own request prior to completion of terms of engagement of Agniveer is not permitted. However, in most exceptional cases, personnel enrolled under this scheme may be released, if sanctioned by competent authority.
- Benefits for personnel Exiting at Four years of Service. After completing four years of service (as applicable), the following benefits will be offered to the exiting individuals:
 - (a) <u>Seva Nidhi Package</u>. Refer Para 5 above. The corpus generated after four years of contribution will be paid to the exiting Agniveers.
 - (b) <u>'Agniveer' Skill Certificate</u>. At the end of engagement period, a detailed skill set certificate will be provided to the Agniveers, highlighting the skills and level of competency acquired by the personnel during the engagement period.
 - (c) Class 12th Certificate. Agriveers who have been enrolled after qualifying class 10th, a certificate for 12th (equivalent) will be given on completion of their 4 years engagement period, based on skills ettained. Detailed instruction shall be issued separately.
- 9. The rally under Agnipath Scheme Unit Headquarters Quota (UHQ) for the recruiting year 2022-23 (applicable only for son/ brother of servinglex-servicemen of ASC Only) has been scheduled to be conducted at this Centre. You are requested to kindly give wide publicity for the same:

- 10. Following priorities will be given as laid down in Policy Directive 2014 issued by IHQ of MoD (Army):-
 - (a) Priority-1 (Battle Casualty/Liberalized Family Pension of ASC).
 - (i) One Son of War Widow in receipt of Liberalized family Pension to include legally adopted Son.
 - (ii) Real brother of Battle Casualty who married the widow of the Battle Casualty.
 - One Son-in-Law of Battle Casualty having no son to include husband of legally adopted daughter.
 - (iv) One real brother of unmarried Battle Casualty.

(b) Priority - 2 (Disability Pensioners/Special Family Pensioners of ASC).

- (i) In respect of Serviceman who died in harness, one son/one legally adopted son or one real brother (if the Serviceman is unmarried) where the Widow/NOK is in receipt of Special Family Pension.
- (ii) One Son/one legally adopted son of Ex-Serviceman or one real brother (if the Ex-Serviceman is unmarried) in receipt of Disability Pension more than 20%, and the disability is attributed to/aggravated by Military Service.

(c) Priority - 3 (Serving/Ex-Serviceman of ASC)

- (i) One son of Serviceman who died in harness to include legally adopted son whose death is not attributed to Military Service.
- (ii) One Son of Serving/Ex-Serviceman to include legally adopted son.
- (iii) One brother of Serviceman/Ex-Serviceman.

(d) Priority – 4 (Other Regt/Corps).

- (i) One son of War Widow to include legally adopted Son.
- (ii) Real brother of Battle Casualty who marries the widow.
- (iii) One son-in-law of war widow having no son to include husband of legally adopted daughter.
- (iv) One real brother of unmarried Battle Casualty.

(e) Priority - 5 (Other Regt/Corps).

- (i) In respect of Serviceman who dies in harness, one son/legally adopted Son or one real brother (if the serviceman is unmarried) where the widow/NOK is in receipt of Special Family Pension.
- (ii) One Son/one legally adopted son of Ex-serviceman or one real brother (if the Ex-serviceman is unmarried) in receipt of Disability Pension more than 20% and the disability is attributed to/ aggravated by Military Service.
- One son of Serviceman who die in harness to include legally adopted son whose death is not attributed to Military Service.
- (iv) One son of Serving/Ex-serviceman to include legally adopted son.
- (v) One brother of Serviceman/Ex-Serviceman.
- (vi) Wards of TA Pers.

Note. Adoption done during the lifetime of a soldier will be valid for the purpose of award of bonus marks/concessions and enrolment through unit HQ quota enrolment.

- Instant Enrolment This facility is provided into the Army as Sol GD to the following candidate through UHQ enrolment.
 - (a) One son of tatal battle casualty/ Battle casualty boarded out.
 - (b) One real brother of battle casualty.
 - (c) One real brother of a Battle Casualty provided the real brother gets married to the deceased widow.
- Category for Recruitment. Recruitment will be carried out for the following category of trades.
 - (a) Agniveer GD (AIAC) (SHT).
 - (b) Agniveer Tdn (AIAC) (Chef).
- 13. The system of application & issue of call letters has been discontinued. Therefore, no application is required to be forwarded to this Centre for recruitment. The candidates should directly report to ASC Centre (South) 2 ATC. Bangalore on the scheduled date as mentioned at para 1 above at <u>0600hours</u>. The candidates should bring the following documents in original which are mandatorily required at the time of screening and one set of photocopy of these documents duly self attested.

(a) Relationship Certificate.

- (i) UHQ quota Relationship certificate of the candidates should be issued by Records Office concerned duly signed by an officer of the concerned Records in original. Relation Certificate issued by DSC Records is not valid.
- (ii) Entirely different name of self, father & mother between 10th mark sheet and relationship certificate will not be entertained.
- (iii) UHQ quota is applicable for only ONE Son/ ONE real Brother of Serviceman/ Ex-serviceman.
- (iv) In case one son already enrolled by availing benefits of relationship certificate of his father then second Son of a Serviceman/ Ex-serviceman can attend UHQ recruitment rally on the basis of relationship certificate of his brother only and NO BONUS MARKS will be awarded to him.
- (v) In case the Relationship certificate is issued to more than one Son/Daughter of the Serviceman/ Ex-serviceman, it is reiterated that only one son/daughter will be allowed to appear in UHQ rally on the basis of relationship of father. The sponsor (Father) has to decide which son should take part earlier. An undertaking to this effect will be submitted by the sponsor that his another son (s) is/are not attending the recruitment rally at other ZRO/ARO/Regimental Centre by using his Relationship Certificate. The same is also applicable for Relationship Certificate issued to multiple brothers. The candidate who is attending the rally should be in possession of relation certificate of his another son/brother/sister.

- (vi) Candidates of Battle Casualty/ Disability Pension (more than 20% and the disability is attributed to/aggravated by Military Service) should be in possession of all original documents/ certificates pertains to Battle Casualty/Disability Pension.
- (b) Education certificate and Marks sheet in original as laid down at Para No 7 below.

(c) Affidavit.

- (i) If any minor variation in date of birth as mentioned in 10th education mark sheet and Relationship certificate issued by Record Office upto 366 days. (Specimen attached at Appx A). Variation of more than 366 days not acceptable.
- (ii) Self Declaration Affidavit from notary for personal details (i.e. name, father's and mother's name, place of birth, address of residence, caste, sub caste, religion) and a certificate/ statement that candidate had or has not been member of any banned/political organization and has never been in custody/jail and no criminal or judicial case is pending against him in any court of law in India. That he has not been ever convicted for any offence under the law. The affidavit being submitted by the candidate at the rally site will also include details of all previous recruitment rallies he has attended since a candidate is permitted to attend recruitment rally based on a Nativity / Domicile certificate declared by him provided he is not getting to appear more than one in a recruiting year. Executive magistrate/SDM of the concerned tehsil with round stamp should signature it (Specimen attached at Appx B).
- (d) Nativity/ Permanent Residential Certificate/ Domicile Certificate/ Mool Niwas Praman Patra. In Hindi / English duly signed by District Magistrate/SDM/DC/ Tehsildar.
- (e) <u>Kandi Area Certificate</u> Kandi area certificate issued by the SDM for personal belonging between Punjab and Himachal border (if applicable).
- (f) Caste Certificate Caste certificate duly signed by DM/SDM/BDO/ Tehsildar/Officers so authorised for SC/ST/OBC. For General category candidates a certificate to this effect duly signed by village Sarpanch/ Pradhan/ Parshad is required on his letter pad. Sub caste, caste and class should be clearly mentioned in caste certificate.
- (g) Police Character Certificate. Character Certificate with photograph duly verified by the concerned Police Station (valid for a period of six months).
- (h) <u>Unmarried/ Married certificate</u> Unmarried/ Married certificate with photograph of the candidate duly signed by Village Sarpanch/Pradhan/ ward member (validity not more than six months from date of issue). Married person below 21 years of age will not be eligible for recruitment except in case of brother of battle casualty married to widow of the battle casualty.

(i) Character Certificate Character certificate duly affixed photograph of the candidate issued by village Sarpanch/ Gram Pradhan/ ward member in Hindi/English with his office seal (validity not more than six months). Validity of certificate will be only six months from the date of issue. Certificate in local language will not be accepted.

(k) Photographs.

- (i) Twenty copies of latest colour passport (size 4.5x3.5 cms) with sky blue background from photo studio only (Polaroid cameral mobile / computerized photo not accepted) are to be brought by the candidate Photograph should be without beard and headgear for non-sikh candidate.
- (ii) Family Photo with family details. One copy of good quality family photo of all members (size 6"x4") duly signed / verified by the village Sarpanch/ Gram Pradhan and affixed with his/her rubber stamp are accepted. Computerized mixed up/ mobile camera family photos or computerized background of photo are not accepted. The family photo should include details of family members in the photographs in English only such as father, mother, self, brothers & sisters with date of birth authenticated by Village Sarpanch/Gram Pradhan alongwith ID proof (aadhar card) of all members. Format attached at Appx "C".
- (I) NCC Certificate 'A'/ 'B'/ 'C'. Certificate be produced in original.
- (m) Sports Certificate (For sports candidate only) Certificate of ment in sports / games of International/ National level, if any. Sports certificate should be within two years between the date of issue of certificate and date of screening of recruitment raily.
- (n) Consent Certificate Candidate between 17 ½ to 18 years on the date of screening should bring Consent Certificate from their parents on affidavit of notary stating that they are willing for enrolment of their son in the Army and will not claim for compensation for any injury caused during screening.
- (o) PAN Card & Aadhar Card. Candidate should be in possession of PAN Card, Aadhar Card and bank account.
- (p) Monthly Pay Slip and family details portion of FS Documents / family details of sponsor printed from Army Intranet duly singed by an officer of the unit in case of serving personnel.
- (q) Discharge book in original of sponsor in case of ex-serviceman / widow / war widow. In case details i.e. Name & Date of birth of family members are not mentioned in discharge book then the same to be obtained from concerned Records office duly signed by concerned Records officer.
- (r) <u>Drug Abuse</u>. An indemnity bond in bilingual (Hindi and English) to the effect that candidate participating in the recruitment rally has not used any means of drug while participating in recruitment rally, duly signed by the candidate will be submitted at the rally site prior to physical fitness test. Format attached at Appx 'D'.

(a) All candidates will be produce a COVID-19 free/asymptomatic cert and No-Roak certificate when they report for the rally. Cert should have been issued.

(t) All candidates will be thermally acreened at the rally site. Candidate having temperature/ showing symptoms, he will not be allowed to participate in the rally.

- (u) Vaccination certificate for age group 18 and above.
- 14. Entirely different name in any of the documents will not be accepted
- 15. Individual reporting for screening test without any of these documents as mentioned in Para 13 (a to r) in original, will not be allowed to participate in the Recruitment rally. Candidates reporting after 0600hours on the scheduled date at rally site will not be allowed to participate in the recruitment rally.

Education Qualification

- 16. List of School Education Boards authorized for enrolment in Army are attached as Appx 'E'. The educational qualification required for enrolment in the Army against Unit HQ quota is as under:
 - (a) Agniveer GD (AIAC) (SHT) Class 10th /Matric with 45% marks in aggregate and 33% in each subject. For boards following grading system, min of D Grade (33% - 40%) in individual sub or grades with 33% in Indi subjects and overall aggregate of C2 grade or equivalent corresponding to 45% in aggregate.
 - (b) Agniveer Tradesman (AIAC) (Chef). Class 10th Simple pass. No stipulation in aggregate percentage but should have scored min 33% in each subject.

17. Age Limit. The cut off date for age limit of candidates will be consider 01 Oct of the ongoing recruiting year as the date for calculation of DOB for max eligible age and 01 Apr of the ongoing recruiting year as the date for calculating min eligible age. The candidates born after the maximum date or before the minimum date mentioned against each trade are not required to report to this Centre as they will be overage / underage respectively for enrolment.

- (d) Permanent body tattoos are only permitted on inner face of forearms i.e from inside of elbow to the wrist and on the reverse side of palm/back (dorsal) side of hand. Permanent body tattoos on any other part of the body are not acceptable and candidates will be barred from further selection. Tribes with tattoo marks on the face or body as per their existing custom and traditions will be permitted on a case to case basis.
- Common Entrance Examination (CEE). All the candidates who have been declared FIT in the medical examination will undergo to a Common Entrance Examination (CEE) which will be conducted at Gill Stadium of this Centre. Date of CEE is 13 Nov 2022.
